Storytime with Ms. Kate

Cost at time of registration: \$20 per class

When: Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, starting July 7th and ending August 22nd

Time: Session 1 (9:15-10:00), Session 2 (10:15-11:00)

Who: Ages 2 and 3

Description: Come experience the magic of the library with your 2 and 3 year old at Storytime! You will have the opportunity to accompany your child in practicing developmentally appropriate skills through fine motor activities, socialization, music, and books. You and your child will learn about a new author each week and participate in a crafts that coincide with the book of the day. This program is also a great way to immerse yourself in the Fire Island community by meeting other families and participating in our "field trips" around town!
